What Qualifications do I need to Teach in Lutheran Education?

Qualifications to teach in Lutheran education include:

Completing the appropriate state qualifications and registration

In schools (only)

Completing requirements for accreditation as a teacher in a Lutheran school during your first three years of working in a Lutheran school (offered as professional learning by the school)

All staff in Lutheran schools and ECSs are expected to uphold the ethos and culture of that School or ECS.

- The opportunity to use and to develop your personal gifts in serving others
- Lutheran schools and ECSs provide teachers with a sense of belonging to a community that values, encourages and supports everyone in that community

- Teachers in a Lutheran school or ECS have a common purpose to educate others in the knowledge of God and of the world
